SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS: After starting 0-2 in league play, Pacific West Conference champion **Dixie State** surged into the playoffs by winning 12 of 13 matches from Oct. 10-Nov. 18 ... the Red Storm, from St. George, Utah, are trying to get back to the NCAA West Regional final as a No. 8 seed for the second year in a row ... Dixie is led by 5-9 Jr. OH Delayne Daniel (2.77 kps, .219 att%, 2.37 dps) and 6-2 Jr. MB Lindsey Jones (2.12 kps, .273 att%, 0.93 bps).

Notes: UAA has won the only meeting in Anchorage with a 3-1 decision in the 2012 Spring Hills Suites Invitational (9/7/12) ... teams have split meetings at the last two GNAC/Pac West Challenges, with Dixie winning 3-2 in 2014 in Riverside, Calif.

SEAWOLF NCAA HISTORY: The Seawolves are making their sixth trip in seven seasons and eighth-ever NCAA Tournament appearance (1989, 1990, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015) ... UAA has lost its last four NCAA 1st Round matches, with the last three coming against the eventual regional champion ... the Seawolves were a No. 2 seed last year – then the program's highest seed ever – when they lost in four sets to eventual regional champ Sonoma State ... UAA was the No. 5 seed in 2009 when it earned its first NCAA win with a 5-set (15-12) 1st Round victory over Hawaii-Hilo in San Bernardino.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: The Seawolves were No. 1 in the third and final version of the NCAA Div. II West Region rankings ... UAA rose to No. 1 in the second poll, marking its first time ever in the top spot ... the third poll was a prelude to the final week of the regular season, leading to the announcement of the NCAA Tournament field.

(2009) and the program's fourth league crown since starting conference play in 1984; the Seawolves won the Continental Divide Conference outright in 1990 and tied for the Pacific West Confer-

ence title in 1992 ... the Seawolves have earned the program's third straight NCAA Tournament bid and the sixth in the last seven years; they also made the 'Big Dance' in 1989 and 1990 ... UAA is the No. 1 regional seed for the first time ever, topping the program-best No. 2 seed from last season.

TEAM NOTES: At 26-2, UAA has clinched the best winning percentage and fewest losses in program history for the second straight season; UAA went 21-6 (.778) in 2014 ... the Seawolves' 26 wins have also surpassed the previous record of 24 (1990, 1992) ... with their 14-0 start, the Seawolves surpassed the old program record of 13 straight wins by the 2009 GNAC title club; the previous best start for a Seawolf team was 10-0 in 1988 ... now with a current 11-match win streak, the Seawolves have produced two of the three longest streaks in program history this year ... UAA was one of the last two remaining unbeaten among the 282 teams in NCAA Div. II – a distinction now held by no team ... the Seawolves lead the GNAC stats in two of seven categories, sporting a .260 attack percentage and .122 opponent attack pct.; they are also 2nd in assists per set (12.7), kills per set (13.7) and aces per set (1.6), and 3rd in blocks per set (2.72)

A HOWL LOTTA LOVE: UAA leads NCAA Div. II in attendance with 1,294 fans per game, producing the top 10 crowds in program history and eight of the top 20 crowds in the nation this year.

... in the NCAA D-II national stats, UAA is 5th in blocking, 12th in opponent attack pct., 14th in attack pct., 32nd in kills per set and 33rd in assists per set ... with a 24-4 record at the Alaska Airlines Center since its opening last fall, UAA is 70-15 at home since 2009 ... dating to last season, UAA has won eight of its last 10 matches against nationally ranked opponents – easily the best stretch in program history ... UAA is now 18-29 against ranked opponents under head coach **Chris Green**; prior to his arrival in 2008, UAA had lost 32 straight to ranked foes ... UAA's attack percentages of .410 at UAF and .402 against Fresno Pacific marked the seventh and eighth times in the GNAC era (since 2001) that the Seawolves topped the .400 plateau; the Fresno Pacific mark was also the highest against a non-conference opponent since 2001 ... the 34 total points by MSU Billings (25-11, 25-10, 25-13) marked the second-fewest allowed by a Seawolf team since the introduction of the 25-point, rally scoring format in 2008 ... the -.060 hitting allowed vs. MSUB was a UAA record for a GNAC match ... with their four victories at the GNAC/Pac West Crossover, the Seawolves have earned their most neutral-court wins since 1999.

A TO ZANDERS: Sr. OH **Katelynn Zanders** was a unanimous choice for her third straight **First Team All-GNAC** award and became the third Seawolf to be voted **GNAC Player of the Year** (Calli Scott, 2009; Jackie Matthisen, 2011) when the league's postseason honors were handed out last week ... Zanders ranks 2nd in the league with 4.33 points per set and 3.75 kps, plus 6th in aces per set (0.31) and 16th in digs per set (3.13) ... six of Zanders's 15 double-doubles this year have come against nationally ranked opponents, pushing her career total to 35 such performances ... now with 1,392 kills, she has moved up to No. 5 on the GNAC's all-time list, needing 50 more to reach No. 4 ... on UAA's career lists, she

Zanders got off to a strong start with all-tourney honors at both the SpringHill Suites Invitational and GNAC/Pac West Crossover, leading both tournaments in kills, and she followed by earning her first GNAC Defensive Player of the Week award for her play on the GNAC-opening Oregon road trip ... Zanders was named the league's Defensive POW again Nov.

2-8 after her consecutive double-doubles against CWU and NNU ... Zanders became the first player in program history to earn All-America recognition two years in a row when she landed on spot on the AVCA's honorable mention squad in 2014; she was an AVCA 2nd Team All-American as a sophomore in 2013.

BIG MACKEY ATTACK: Sr. RS **Julia Mackey** has become the first player in league history to earn **First Team All-GNAC** honors for four straight seasons ... the Fairbanks (West Valley HS) product is the only player in the league's top 10 in both attack percentage (.311, 5th) and kills per set (8th, 3.06), while ranking 4th in points per set (3.78) ... Mackey has registered double-figure kills in 17 of 28 matches – including five ‘double-doubles’ – and hit .500 or better on six occasions ... she was named the MVP of the season-opening SpringHill Suites Invitational after smashing 48 kills on .398 hitting, including a .600 (12-0-20) performance in the sweep of Cal Poly Pomona ... like Zanders, Mackey has moved steadily up UAA's career lists, now with ranks of 5th in total kills (1,107), 7th in kills per set (3.08), 7th in attack pct. (.273), 9th in block assists (219) and 11th in total blocks (235) ... Mackey recently joined Jen Szczerbinski, Brianne McCabe and Sabrina Bingham as the fourth player in program history with at least 1,000 kills and 200 blocks ... she was an honorable mention AVCA All-American as a junior in 2014 and the GNAC co-Freshman of the Year in 2012.

THE HOOE PACKAGE: Coming off honorable mention All-GNAC honors last year, Jr. S **Morgan Hooe** rose to the elite level this season with a league-leading 10.67 assists per set and **First Team All-GNAC** honors ... under Hooe's guidance, the Seawolf offense leads the GNAC in attack pct. (.260) and ranks 2nd in kills per set (13.68), producing nine matches with a plus-.300 hitting percentage, including six straight from Sept. 4-13 ... Hooe's career-high 55 assists in the wins over No. 23 Rockhurst and at Western Oregon remain the top performances for a GNAC setter this year, while her 44 against Dixie State stand as the second-best in a 3-setter ... the former South Anchorage HS star earned a spot on the SpringHill Suites Invitational all-tourney team to start the season, leading the 5-team event in assists ... Hooe has also proven an efficient offense force herself, with her .288 attack pct. ranking third-best on the team ... on UAA's career lists, she has risen to No. 5 in total assists (2,395) and No. 6 in assists per set (8.11), having shared time in a '6-2' offensive system her freshman season.

MIDDLE MANAGEMENT: The middle blocking duo of Jr. **Erin Braun** and Sr. **Caitlin Hanson** has been a big reason behind the Seawolves' top-15 NCAA team ranks in both attack pct. and blocking ... coming off an honorable mention All-GNAC sophomore campaign, Braun currently ranks 7th in the GNAC in both blocks per set (1.23) and attack pct. (.295) ... the San Bernardino, Calif., native has posted at least four kills in 22 of 28 matches this year and had 12 matches with at least 5 total blocks ... on UAA's all-time lists, Braun is 3rd in attack pct. (.300), 5th in block assists (285), 1-8th in total blocks (308) and 8th in blocks per set (1.05) ... meanwhile, Hanson picked up an **honorable mention All-GNAC** award last week after finishing the regular season with league ranks of 9th in bps (1.10) and 12th in attack pct. ROCKIN' ROOKIES: UAA's freshman duo of libero **Kyla Militante-Amper** and OH **Leah Swiss** has been a key reason the Seawolves are enjoying the best season in program history ... coming off a red-shirt season, Swiss has proven to be one of the top players in the GNAC regardless of experience, giving the Seawolves a league-

best four First Team All-GNAC honorees ... Swiss holds GNAC ranks of 18th in attack pct. (.233), 14th in points per set (3.26), 16th in kills per set (2.54) and 3rd in aces per set (0.40), while she is third on the team with 2.66 digs pser set ... the 2-time Alaska Gatorade Player of the Year at Anchorage's Dimond High School, Swiss led the entire 8-team GNAC/Pac West Crossover with a .419 attack pct. and was named to the event's all-tournament squad ... since hitting under .100 in the first two matches, Swiss has connected at .225 or better in 14 of 26 contests, including .533 against Dixie State and .476 against No. 20 BYU-Hawaii ... meanwhile, Militante-Amper also picked up some hardware this season, twice earning GNAC Defensive Player of the Week -- for her play at the GNAC/Pac West Crossover in the final week of the regular season vs. Concordia and WOU ... the Hillsboro, Ore. (Century HS) product led the Seawolves with 65 digs in the Crossover, including 23 against then-No. 21 Point Loma ... Militante-Amper has registered at least 15 digs in 14 of the 22 matches in which she has played the whole way, along with 14-dig performances in sweeps of Saint Martin's, MSU Billings and Seattle Pacific ... with an impressive 6.85 dps over the last four matches, she has risen to 5th in the GNAC at 4.37 dps for the season ... Militante-Amper has also excelled in her role as UAA's secondary setter, notching at least five assists on four occasions ... meanwhile, another East Anchorage HS product, Fr. OH **Taylor Noga**, has established herself as UAA's regular serving specialist, appearing in 95 of 100 sets thus far ... Noga served a career-high 3 aces in UAA's win at Central Washington, and she proved a capable back-up libero, averaging 4.18 digs per set in Militante-Amper's absence against Western Washington, Simon Fraser and UAF in October.

GREEN MACHINE: Having now led UAA to its unprecedented 8th straight winning season, UAA head coach **Chris Green** (158-68, .696) continues to establish himself as the most successful coach in program history and one of the top mentors in the NCAA Div. II ranks ... now a **3-time GNAC Coach of the Year** (2009, 2013, 2015), Green has led UAA to NCAA Tournament berths in six of the last seven seasons, capturing the program's highest-ever seeds the last two seasons ... in the 28 years before Green's arrival, the Seawolves made two NCAAs ... UAA has won at a .791 clip (68-18) since the start of the 2013 campaign, including .857 (48-8) in league play ... after helping the Seawolves to a 10-win turnaround in his first season, Green earned both GNAC and NCAA Div. II West Region coach-of-the-year honors in 2009 when he piloted UAA to the GNAC title and the program's first-ever NCAA victory ... in 2011, Green led the Seawolves to their third straight NCAA Tournament bid and an 18-9 record ... Green's UAA teams have also produced three All-Americans, three GNAC Players of the Year, five GNAC Newcomers of the Year and two GNAC Freshmen of the Year ... hired in Feb. 2008 as the sixth coach in UAA Volleyball history, Green spent the previous nine seasons (1999-07) as the head coach at Western Nebraska Community College, where he built a powerhouse program. Among his list of accomplishments at WNCC were a 453-55 record, the 2007 NJCAA Div.
