THE WEEK AHEAD...the Western Washington University volleyball team is the No. 2 seed at the West Regional of the 2015 NCAA Division II National Championships, taking place this Friday-Sunday (Dec. 4-6) at host and No.1 seed Alaska-Anchorage (Alaska Airlines Center – Anchorage, AK)...the Vikings will face No. 7 seed Point Loma Friday at 2:30 pm AT/3:30 pm PT.

UP NEXT...the winner of the WWU/PL match will face the winner of the UCSD/Sonoma State match Saturday at 6 pm/7 pm...the regional final will be held Sunday at 4 pm/5 pm PT...the winner of the NCAA West Region advances to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight Dec. 10-12, in Tampa, Fla.

VIKINGS NCAA HISTORY...the Vikings will be making the program's ninth trip to the NCAA Division II Tournament, and a record fourth consecutive trip to the regionals...the No. 2 seed is tied for the highest in program history, joining 2007 (advanced to NCAA II title match) and 2003...have an all-time 8-8 record in NCAA Tournament play.

THE RECORD...earned an at-large regional berth after finishing 2nd in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference with a 17-3 record, including a perfect 10-0 road record...the 20-win season is the fourth consecutive...**all 5 of the Vikings losses were against teams that were ranked at some point during the season in the AVCA Division II Top 25** (includes preseason poll).

NATIONAL RANKINGS...the Vikings finished the regular season ranked No. 16 in the AVCA Division II Coaches Top 25 poll...opened the season ranked No. 24 in the nation and has peaked at No. 10 in the nation...finished last season ranked No. 22 in the nation...have finished with a top 25 ranking in 6 of the last 8 seasons.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS...finished the regular season leading the GNAC in kills (13.81 per set) and assists (12.81 per set), and were 2nd in hitting percentage (.254) and digs (16.69 per set)...in the national stats, the Vikings rank 16th in Division II in both blocks per set (2.48) and hitting percentage (.254), and 27th in assists per set (12.81).

SERIES HISTORY...WWU leads the all-time series vs. Point Loma 2-1, including a 3-set sweep (25-21, 27-25, 25-15) over the then No. 20 ranked Sea Lions Sept. 12 at the GNAC/PacWest Crossover in Ellensburg, WA...Point Loma enters the NCAA Tournament with a 20-9 record and won 12 of last 13 matches.

GNAC AWARDS...Abby Phelps was named the GNAC Freshman of the Year on the 2015 GNAC Volleyball All-Conference team, joining outside hitter Rachel Roeder and middle blocker Kayleigh Harper as first-team All-GNAC selections...opposite Jennica McPherson earned honorable mention honors...Phelps is the first Western player to be named GNAC Freshman of the Year since outside hitter Marlayna Geary in 2009, and fourth overall since joining the GNAC in 2001.

GNAC STANDINGS...finished 2nd in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference with a 17-3 record...trailed conference winner Alaska-Anchorage by one game in the win column (18-2 record)...went a perfect 10-0 on the road in GNAC play..

THE STREAK HAD TO END SOMETIME...the Vikings had a 16-match winning streak (Sept.5-Oct. 17) snapped with 3-0 loss vs. Northwest Nazarene (10/22)...after opening the season with a pair of 3-0 defeats vs. Wheeling Jesuit (currently No. 10 in the nation) and Tampa (currently No. 3 in the nation), the Vikings reeled off 16 straight wins...recorded 9 three-game sweeps and won 48 of 58 sets during the win streak...**16-match winning streak goes in the record books as the 5th-longest in program history, trailing 24 (2003), 21 (2007), 20 (2001) and 18 (2002) match win streaks.**

COACH FLICK...Diane Flick is in her 16th season directing the WWU Volleyball program...owns a career record of 340-90 (.791)...Flick has guided the Vikings to 11 seasons of 20 or more victories, 9 NCAA Tournament appearances, 7 Great Northwest Athletic Conference championships and received GNAC Coach of the Year honors 8 times (2001-03, 2006, 2007, 2010, 2012-13).

STUDENT-ATHLETES...junior libero **Bryce Larson** (Mukilteo, WA), senior opposite **Jennica McPherson** (Seattle, WA/Kennedy), senior outside hitter **Rachel Roeder** (Sammamish, WA/Issaquah, WA) and sophomore setter **Kristina Tribley** (Wenatchee, WA) were named to the 2015 Great Northwest Athletic Conference Volleyball All-Academic Team for the exemplary performance in the classroom as student-athletes.

MORE FROM THE CLASSROOM...according to @NCAAResearch, 34 of the 64 teams in the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Tournament have graduation rates (ASR) of 90% or higher...WWU is one of 15 with 100%.

WHAT A PERFORMANCE...middle blocker **Kayleigh Harper** (RS Fr./Oak Harbor, WA) recorded 15 kills on .882 hitting percentage in the sweep vs. Montana State Billings on Oct. 31...set the WWU and tallied the 4th-best hitting percentage in a match by a GNAC player (min. 12 kills)...her .882 percentage has bettered only by Morgan Zamora in 2006 (CWU, .929, 13 kills), Korlyn Bolster in 2007 (Alaska Fairbanks, .929, 13 kills) and Courtney Lundberg in 2009 (Alaska Anchorage, .895, 2009)...previous highest hitting percentage with at least 12 kills by a WWU player was .786 by Kayla Erickson (12 kills, 14 attempts) on Sept. 7, 2012 vs. Cal State Stanislaus.

STATISTICALLY SPEAKING...several Vikings rank amongst leaders in the GNAC & NCAA II:

- **Kayleigh Harper** - Blocks/S (2nd/1.40), Hitting% (3rd/.335)...6th nationally in blocks per set.
- **Abby Phelps** - Points/S (7th/3.56), Kills/S (9th/3.04)...team-high 8 double-doubles.
- **Rachel Roeder** - Kills/S (6th/3.19), Points/S (8th/3.48)
- **Jennica McPherson** - Service Aces/S (5th/0.32), Digs/S (6th/3.84)

TRUE ROAD WARRIORS...the Vikings played all but one of its 2015 home matches at Whatcom Community College while their on-campus arena, Carver Gymnasium, undergoes a 2-year renovation...also played one game at Squalicum High School.

ALASKA STATE OF MIND...the Vikings were 2-0 this season in Alaska, beating then No. 10 Anchorage in 5 sets (25-16, 25-22, 15-25, 22-25, 16-14) and Fairbanks in 3 sets...has won last 4 matches in Anchorage vs. the Seawolves (dating back to 2012) and won 7 straight in Fairbanks.

VIKING NOTES...

- **Single-Season Blocks** - **Kayleigh Harper** has recorded 137 total blocks this season (25 solo, 112 block assists), 8th-most total blocks in single-season WWU history.
- **Block Party** - Rank 16th in NCAA II with **2.48 blocks per set**.
- **Double-Doubles** - **Abby Phelps** leads the team lead with 8 double-doubles...**Joellee Buckner** has 6.
- **Brette Boesel** leads the team with 6.83 assists/set and 2nd with 28 service aces.
- The senior class of **Jennica McPherson** and **Rachel Roeder** have combined to go 91-20.
