It has been 25 years since **Kim Cherniss** (left) grasped the reins of the Coyote volleyball program, and over the past two-plus decades, the 2008 AVCA and NCAA Division II Coach of the Year, four-time AVCA West Region and five-time CCAA Coach of the Year has built a powerhouse in volleyball. She has led the Coyotes to the NCAA West Regional in each of the past 16 seasons, reaching the final 14 consecutive years (2000-13). Her teams have won 20 or more matches a remarkable 19 consecutive seasons and captured 11 of the past 15 CCAA championships. In 2011, the Coyotes finished the regular season

unbeaten (28-0) and CCAA play undefeated (22-0) for a record-setting season. They established a record 32-match winning streak and earned their fourth consecutive NCAA West Region title and finished second in the country in the NCAA Championships played at CSUSB. The Coyotes, led by two-time National Player of the Year Samantha Middleborn, earned their sixth consecutive CCAA title and ninth in history. The 2010 season saw the Coyotes reach yet another 20-win season and capture the CCAA and NCAA West Region titles. The Coyotes boasted four All-Americans on the squad including consensus National Player of the Year Samantha Middleborn. They won the NCAA regional title for a third straight year and their fifth in the last eight years. In CCAA play, the Coyotes cruised to a 21-1 record for the second straight year and won their fifth straight CCAA title – a better run than any other female program in the conference. Her 2008 team went 30-4, won the CCAA for the third straight year and sixth time in the last eight years, then won the West Regional for the third time and advanced to the NCAA championship match for the first time in the history of the program, losing to Concordia-St.

Paul, 3-2, in the title match in St. Paul, Minn. Cherniss picked up her 500th career win in 2013 with a 3-0 win over Fort Lewis State. Oct. 10. Over the past 13 seasons, Cherniss has coached 25 AVCA All-Americans and 11 Daktronics All-Americans. She coached back-to-back AVCA Players of the Year with Kim Morohunfolo in 2003 and Brianna Harris in 2004. She also coached the 2005 AVCA Freshman of the Year in Traci Weamer. No less than five Coyotes have been named All-CCAA in each of the past nine seasons. Also in 2009, Danny Scott was named the Division II Assistant Coach of the Year. Cherniss was a two-time all-America selection at UC Riverside. She was a member of the Highlanders' 1982 NCAA championship team. She was inducted into the UCR Sports Hall of Fame in 1991, the same year she began coaching the Coyotes. She is a 1986 graduate of UC Riverside and received her California teaching credential in physical education in 1993.
